# A BILL FOR

An Act to enable two (2) or more cities to jointly construct  
a swimming pool and providing for the issuance of bonds and  
the levy of taxes by such cities to finance the swimming  
pool.

*Senate concurs in (H) amend-  
ment as amended  
4-29 votes  
ayes 44 - nays 0*

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Any two (2) or more cities or towns may contract  
 2 with each other for the joint purchase, acquisition, ownership  
 3 and control of real or other property suitable as the site of  
 4 a swimming pool and for joint construction, erection,  
 5 improvement, operation and maintenance of a swimming pool upon  
 6 such site. Any or all of such cities and towns for the purpose  
 7 of paying its respective share of the cost under such a contract  
 8 may issue bonds and levy a tax sufficient to meet the principal  
 9 and interest on such bonds or otherwise pay such costs, or  
 10 both. For all such purposes, such cities and towns and the  
 11 councils thereof, singly or collectively, shall have all of the  
 12 powers, duties, rights, authority, responsibilities and follow  
 13 the same rules and procedure as authorized, granted and  
 14 prescribed in sections three hundred sixty-eight point  
 15 nineteen (368.19) to three hundred sixty-eight point twenty-two  
 16 (368.22) inclusive, of the Code, for cities or towns and counties  
 17 and the governing bodies thereof, in the acquisition of a site,  
 18 and the construction and operation of joint city and county  
 19 buildings.

20 This section and those parts of sections three hundred  
 21 sixty-eight point nineteen (368.19) to three hundred sixty-eight  
 22 point twenty-two (368.22) referred to herein shall be construed  
 23 as a complete and independent law for providing joint swimming  
 24 pools for two (2) or more cities or towns and for the issuance  
 25 of bonds in connection therewith.
