A BILL FOR

An Act to include musk thistles in the category of primary noxious weeds.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred seventeen point one (317.1),
- 2 Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking the period (.) at the
- 3 end of subsection one (1) and by inserting in lieu thereof the
- 4 following: " , musk-thistles (carduus nutans)."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 29

The weed popularly called musk thistle, and scientifically entitled *carduus nutans*, by this act will be included in the class of primary noxious weeds as enumerated by section 317.1, subsection 1.

The remaining portions of this act applicable to "primary noxious weeds" will henceforth include the weed musk thistles (*carduus nutans*).

Amend House File 29 as follows:

By striking everything after the enacting clause and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 1. Section three hundred seventeen point one (317.1) Code 1958, is hereby amended by inserting after the comma in line five (5) the following:

"and all other species of thistles belonging in genera of *Cirsium* and *Carduus*."
