A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section one hundred ten point seventeen (110.17), Code 1958, relating to hunting, fishing and trapping license requirements for landowners and tenants of land and their children.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point seventeen (110.17),
- 2 Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking lines one (1) and two
- 3 (2) and that part of line three (3) through and including the
- 4 word "lands" and inserting in lieu thereof the following, "Owners
- 5 and tenants of lands and their children living with them, may hunt,
- 6 fish or trap upon such land on which they reside".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 101

In the law it was clearly intended by the legislators that free hunting privileges were for owners or tenants and their children living at home. This amendment sets out this fact more clearly.
