# A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred ninety-six (196), Code 1958, relating to the buying and selling of eggs.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred ninety-six point six (196.6),  
2 Code 1958, is amended by striking all of said section after the  
3 word "be" in line three (3) and inserting in lieu thereof the  
4 following: "ten dollars. Each license shall expire and is  
5 renewable on July first of each year."

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred ninety-six point twelve  
2 (196.12), Code 1958, is hereby repealed and the following is  
3 substituted in lieu thereof: "Every person buying eggs from  
4 producers for resale shall candle or cause to be candled, or,  
5 candle and grade, or cause to be candled and graded, according  
6 to grades established by United States department of agriculture  
7 for quality and size of all eggs thus purchased, and shall  
8 refuse to buy all eggs unfit for human consumption. Such  
9 candling, or candling and grading, shall be done in the presence  
10 of the producer if requested."

1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred ninety six point fourteen  
2 (196.14), Code 1958, is amended by striking lines one (1) to  
3 six (6) inclusive and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
4 "All eggs offered for sale at retail must be candled, graded

5 and labeled, and no eggs shall be sold as ungraded, nest run,  
 6 current receipts, or by any other name which might be misleading.  
 7 Maximum tolerance of ten percent (10%) may be allowed on quality  
 8 in grades."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 121

These changes are desirable to improve the enforcement of our present law regarding buying and selling of eggs.

1 Amend House File 121 by adding in line five (5) of section  
 2 one (1) after the word "year." a new sentence reading as follows:  
 3 "All licenses issued under this section after April 1, 1959 and  
 4 prior to July 4, 1959, are hereby extended to July 1, 1960."  
 5 Further amend said House File 121 by adding in line five (5)  
 6 of section two (2) after the word, "graded" the words, "all such  
 7 eggs".

 3 is amended by striking the period at the end thereof, inserting

 5 loss or inedible as defined by the United States standards and  
 6 grades of eggs."

 13 cause to be candled and graded."
