A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the per diem salary of county, municipal,
and school examiners.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section eleven point nine (11.9), Code 1958, is
2 amended by striking from line three (3) the word "eighteen" and
3 inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty-two".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 199

County, municipal and school examiners from the office of the auditor of state are required to make examinations and audits of cities, towns, schools and county offices. For this specialized service, a survey shows that salaries of certified public accountants for this same type of work far exceeds that of the state auditor's examiners. No one expects the state to match salaries of private business, and the proposed amendment does not attempt to equalize the difference mentioned. It will, however, have the effect of recognizing the qualifications and the ability to execute such identical duties. Chapter 11, section 11.21, provides for repayment by the city, town, school and county. Therefore, no additional appropriation is required for the passage of said bill.
