A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for an engineering survey preparatory to the establishment of a state-owned lake in Boone County and to make appropriation therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The state conservation commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to conduct an engineering survey for
3 the establishment of a state-owned lake in Boone County.
4 Said lake shall be such as will adequately provide the people
5 of Boone County with flood control, water conservation,
6 recreational fishing and hunting facilities.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds
2 of the state of Iowa not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
3 ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary for the payment of expense of conducting
5 the engineering survey as here directed.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 288

The purpose of this bill is to provide for an engineering survey in Boone County for a state-owned lake.

At present Boone County has no lake for water conservation, water supply, flood control or water recreational facilities.

If the survey finds a suitable location for a state-owned lake, the next legislature will be asked to make appropriations for its development.
