A BILL FOR

An Act to regulate and control importation of swine into Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section (1) After July 1, 1959, no swine shall be imported
2 into Iowa for feeding or breeding purposes without first having
3 affixed in the right ear of each animal a numbered tag and
4 accompanied by a health certificate issued by a qualified
5 veterinarian. A copy of the health certificate shall be promptly
6 forwarded to the animal industry division of the Iowa department
7 of agriculture. Such certificates shall include a statement
8 showing that the swine have been inspected within forty-eight
9 hours prior to the time of importation and that there are no
10 symptoms of any infectious, contagious or communicable disease,
11 and a statement that the swine have been immunized against hog
12 cholera by one of the methods described by statute, unless a
13 permit allowing importation subject to immunization upon arrival
14 has been obtained. The health certificate shall further include
15 the ear tag numbers of all swine in the shipment.
16 Blanks for health certificates and ear tags shall be furnished
17 by the department of agriculture at cost, when applied for by the
18 importer.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 318

This bill will create effective control on importations of feeder pigs into Iowa so as to eliminate the bringing into our state of diseased pigs.

- 10 or his authorized agent, a record of the origin of all such animals
- 11 for a period of at least one (1) year after date of entry of the animals
- 12 into Iowa."
