A BILL FOR

An Act relating to fees of the clerk of court in the settlement of estates of decedents, minors, mentally ill persons, or other persons under legal disability.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Subsection twenty-nine (29) of section six
2 hundred six point fifteen (606.15), Code 1958, is hereby
3 amended as follows:

4 1. By striking in lines eight (8) and nine (9) of such
5 subsection the word "personal".

6 2. By striking in lines ten (10) and eleven (11) of such
7 subsection the words "sold for the payment of debts of the
8 deceased".

9 3. By striking in line twenty (20) of such subsection the
10 word "twenty-five" and by inserting in lieu thereof the
11 word "fifteen (15)".

12 4. By inserting after the semicolon in line twenty-one
13 (21) of such subsection the following:

14 "where such value is between fifteen thousand dollars
15 (\$15,000.00) and twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), thirty
16 dollars (\$30.00)";

17 5. By striking in line twenty-two (22) of such subsection
18 the words "twenty-five" and by inserting in lieu thereof
19 the word "five (5)".

20 6. By striking in line twenty-four (24) of such subsection

- 21 the word "fifteen" and by inserting in lieu thereof the
22 words "seven dollars fifty cents (\$7.50)".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 611

This act would base the fee of the clerk of court for settlement of estates upon personal and real property instead of only personal property. It also would raise the amount of the fee for estates over \$15,000.
