A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the registration tolerance of vehicles
transporting raw farm products.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point four
- 2 hundred sixty-six (321.466), Code 1958, is hereby amended by
- 3 adding thereto the following:
- 4 "For the purposes of this section cracked or ground soy
- 5 beans, sargo, corn, wheat, rye, oats or other grain shall be
- 6 deemed to be raw farm products, provided that such products are
- 7 being directly delivered to a farm, from the place where the
- 8 whole grain had been delivered from a farm for the purpose of
- 9 cracking or grinding and immedate delivery to the farm to
- 10 which such cracked or ground products are being delivered."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 638

Section 321.466, Code 1958, grants a registration tolerance of 25 per cent on raw farm products. Cracked grains have been construed not to be "raw farm products." It results that a farmer who takes a load of grain to be cracked or ground and returns to his farm with the cracked product cannot transport the entire load on the return trip. This bill would permit delivery of a load of whole grain, under the tolerance to be cracked or ground, and then delivered to a farm, permitting the tolerance on the cracked or ground product that the statute grants to the whole grain.

- 1 Amend House File 638 by adding thereto a new paragraph
- 2 to section one (1) as follows:
- 3 "The truck operator shall have in his possession a
- 4 receipt showing place of processing on his return trip."
