A BILL FOR

An Act providing for veterinary inspection of animals passing through sale yards or barns.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. In order to prevent the spread of animal
- 2 diseases through the state, the state department of agriculture
- 3 shall levy a veterinary inspection fee against all animals
- 4 passing through sale yards and barns or other marketing agencies
- 5 having permits issued by the department. This section shall not
- 6 apply to meat processing establishments. The department shall
- 7 pay approved veterinarians for such inspectional services out of
- 8 the fees so collected. Such fees when collected shall be placed
- 9 by the secretary in an "inspection fee revolving fund" under his
- 10 jurisdiction to pay the administration of this section. Such
- 11 fees shall be adjusted from time to time so that the amount
- 12 collected will not exceed the costs of said veterinary inspec-
- 13 tions and the administration thereof.
