A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section two hundred thirty-nine point four (239.4), Code 1958, relating to investigation of applications in aid to dependent children cases.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred thirty-nine point four
2 (239.4), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following paragraph: "The investigation shall also ascertain,
4 insofar as possible, the names, addresses or whereabouts,
5 description, and social security numbers of all persons legally
6 responsible for the support of the child and all such other
7 information pertinent thereto as the county attorney may request.
8 When deemed necessary by the county attorney, the county board
9 shall communicate with the social security administration to
10 determine the whereabouts and earnings of a responsible relative,
11 and shall make all information discovered thereby available to
12 the county attorney."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 472

The Social Security administration will not presently make information available to the county attorney relative to whereabouts and earnings of a responsible relative, but will make it available to county boards of social welfare. This bill will assist the county attorney in locating responsible relatives for obtaining support or prosecution.
