A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the fair board for capital improvements.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state to the fair board the sum of one hundred
3 eighty-four thousand six hundred fifty dollars (\$184,650.00).

1 Sec. 2. Said sum shall be allocated in the following amounts:

2 Cattle barn—painting, new built-up roof, gutter and	
3 downspout	\$11,400.00
4 Women's and children's building—painting, roofing	
5 cornice, gutter and downspout.....	37,000.00
6 Horse barn—painting, replace windows, gutter and	
7 downspout	7,590.00
8 Sheep barn—roofing, gutter and downspout.....	14,000.00
9 Swine barn—painting, roofing, replace windows,	
10 gutter and downspout.....	10,350.00
11 Baby beef barn—roofing, gutter and downspout.....	3,340.00
12 Agriculture building—painting, roofing, cornice	
13 and ceilings	10,950.00
14 Livestock pavilion—painting, roofing, cornice, gutter	
15 and downspout	18,650.00
16 Grandstand—painting, roofing, replace steps, re-	
17 place railing	21,730.00

18	Varied industries building—painting and roofing.....	17,840.00
19	Administration building—painting, roofing, rewire,	
20	repair porch, foundation and floors.....	5,925.00
21	Prevention of loss of elm trees.....	3,000.00
22	Water mains and hydrants.....	12,875.00
23	Electric lines—rebuild	10,000.00

1 Sec. 3. Before any of the funds hereinabove appropriated
2 shall be expended it shall be determined by the state fair
3 board, with the approval of the executive council, that the
4 expenditures shall be for the best interests of the state.

1 Sec. 4. Upon the completion of this project as set forth in
2 this Act, any unobligated balance remaining may be used for
3 such other repairs or projects as needed.

1 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
3 and publication as provided by law, in the,
4 a newspaper published at, Iowa, and in the
5, a newspaper published at,
6 Iowa.

1 Amend House File 716, section two (2), by adding at the
2 end thereof the following:
3 The state fair board, with the approval of the executive
4 council, shall employ a competent architect to draw up plans
5 and specifications for the repairs hereinabove listed. Advertise-
6 ments for bids for both labor and materials shall be inserted in
7 newspapers in the same manner as used for highway contracts, and
8 the contracts shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder
9 or bidders.
