relating to representation in the General Assembly.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

EXPLANATION OF H. J. R. 7

The purpose of this joint resolution is to reapportion legislative seats among the counties. It provides for sixty (60) senatorial districts to be allotted on a population basis and ninety-nine (99) representative districts to be allotted one to a county.
