An Act relating to the overall length of combinations of vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point four  
2 hundred fifty-seven (321.457), Code 1962, is hereby amended by  
3 striking the word, "No," in line one (1) of subsection three (3)  
4 and by inserting in lieu thereof the words, "Except as to combi-  
5 nations of vehicles, provisions for which are otherwise made in  
6 this chapter, no".

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point four hundred  
2 fifty-seven (321.457), Code 1962, is further amended by strik-  
3 ing the words, "fifty feet," in line five (5) of subsection  
4 three (3) and by inserting in lieu thereof the words, "fifty-  
5 five (55) feet".

1 Sec. 3. Section three hundred twenty-one point four hun-  
2 dred fifty-seven (321.457), Code 1962, is further amended by add-  
3 ing thereto the following new subsections:

4 1. "No combination of vehicles coupled together which are  
5 used exclusively for the transportation of vehicles and boats,  
6 unladen or with load, shall have an overall length, inclusive of  
7 front and rear bumpers in excess of sixty (60) feet."

8 2. "No combination of three (3) vehicles coupled together  
9 one of which is a motor vehicle, unladen or with load, shall have

10 an overall length, inclusive of front and rear bumpers in excess

11 of sixty (60) feet."
