A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section eighty-nine point seven (89.7), Code 1962, relating to shop and special inspections.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section eighty-nine point seven (89.7), Code
- 2 1962, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection:
- 3 "Inspections made at the request of a boiler or tank
- 4 manufacturer by the chief inspector or any deputy inspector,
- 5 shall be charged for at the rate currently charged by the
- 6 various insurance companies for performing a similar service.
- 7 This charge shall not void the regular fee for inspection or
- 8 certificate when the boiler or tank is installed."

- 1 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
- 2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication
- 3 in the Sioux City Journal, a newspaper published at Sioux City,
- 4 Iowa, and in The Correctionville News, a newspaper published at
- 5 Correctionville, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 386

This bill is deemed necessary so that it will be possible for the boiler division, of the Bureau of Labor, to inspect boilers and tanks of all types at the request of the manufacturer. This inspection is desirable to the manufacturer so that the product shall be readily acceptable when shipped to the other states, having similar inspection, for use there.

It has been found that at least one manufacturer has been having difficulty getting insurance companies to perform this service due to other duties for which they need their qualified inspectors. The charge to the manufacturer for fees and expenses has been set to coincide with the fees and charges of the private insurance companies to eliminate competition with them which we believe is in keeping with other provisions of chapter 89, Code 1962. This bill will cause an inspector to be available when needed by a manufacturer to continue operation of the plant.
