7 salary of his or her principal. Upon certification to
8 the board of supervisors by the elected official concerned,
9 the amount of the annual salary for each deputy as above
0 provided, the board of supervisors shall certify to the
1 county auditor of any such county the annual salary certi-
2 fied by the elected officials, but in no event shall said
3 board of supervisors be required to certify to the auditor
4 of any such county an amount in excess of the amounts
5 authorized above. The board of supervisors shall fix all
6 compensation for extra help and clerks."

 10 'Each county attorney shall receive as his annual salary in
 11 counties having a population of:
 12 1. Less than twenty thousand (20,000) population, six thousand
 13 (6,000) dollars.
 14 2. Twenty thousand (20,000) and less than twenty-five thousand
 15 (25,000) population, sixty-five hundred (6,500) dollars.
 16 3. Twenty-five thousand (25,000) and less than thirty thousand
 17 (30,000) population, seven thousand (7,000) dollars.
 18 4. Thirty thousand (30,000) and less than thirty-five thousand
 19 (35,000) population, seventy-five hundred (7,500) dollars.
 20 5. Thirty-five thousand (35,000) and less than fifty thousand
 21 (50,000) population, eighty-five hundred (8,500) dollars.
 22 6. Fifty thousand (50,000) and less than seventy-five thousand
 23 population, nine thousand (9,000) dollars.
 24 7. Seventy-five thousand (75,000) and less than one hundred
 25 thousand (100,000) population, ten thousand (10,000) dollars.
 26 8. One hundred thousand (100,000) and less than one hundred
 27 fifty thousand (150,000) population, eleven thousand (11,000)
 28 dollars.
 29 9. One hundred fifty thousand (150,000) population, and
 30 less than two hundred thousand (200,000) population, thirteen
 31 thousand (13,000) dollars.
 32 10. Over two hundred thousand (200,000) population, fifteen
 33 thousand (15,000) dollars.
 34 The annual salaries as provided herein shall be the full and
 35 only compensation for the duties performed in the office of the
 36 county attorney, and all fees and commissions which may be lawfully
 37 taxed in favor of the county attorney shall if and when taxed and
 38 collected be paid by the county attorney to the county for the
 39 benefit of the court expense fund.
 40 In counties where district court is held in two (2) places,
 41 the county attorney shall receive an additional sum of five hun-
 42 dred (500) dollars.
 43 The county attorney shall also receive his necessary and actual
 44 expenses incurred in attending upon his official duties other than
 45 his residence and the county seat, which shall be audited and al-
 46 lowed by the board of supervisors of the county.'

 48 1962, is hereby amended as follows:
 49 1. By striking from line seven (7) of subsection one (1) of
 50 such section the word 'seventy-five' and inserting in lieu thereof

- 6 '340.8. Deputy sheriff. Each deputy sheriff shall receive as
- 7 his annual salary as follows:
- 8 '1. The first deputy sheriff, and the second such deputy if
- 9 a second deputy sheriff is required, shall receive an annual
- 10 salary of not more than eighty-five percent of the amount of the
- 11 salary of the sheriff, as fixed by the board of supervisors.
- 12 '2. All other deputy sheriffs shall receive an annual salary
- 13 as fixed by the board of supervisors, but not to exceed the
- 14 salaries of the first or second deputies.
- 15 '3. In any county where district court is held in two places,
- 16 for any deputy other than the chief deputy in charge of the
- 17 office where such court is held outside the county seat, seventy-
- 18 five percent of the amount of the salary of the sheriff but not
- 19 to exceed three thousand dollars.
- 20 'In counties over 250,000 population where more than two (2)
- 21 deputies are required, said deputies may be paid an amount not
- 22 to exceed seventy-five percent of the annual salary of his or
- 23 her principal. Upon certification to the board of supervisors
- 24 by the elected official concerned, the amount of the annual
- 25 salary for each deputy as above provided, the board of supervisors
- 26 shall certify to the county auditor of any such county the annual
- 27 salary certified by the elected officials, but in no event shall
- 28 said board of supervisors be required to certify to the auditor
- 29 of any such county an amount in excess of the amounts authorized
- 30 above. The board of supervisors shall fix all compensation for
- 31 extra help and clerks."
