# A BILL FOR

*education 7/16  
be indefinitely postponed 7/1*

An Act relating to the purchase of uniforms for vocal and instrumental school music groups.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-nine point twenty-five  
2 (279.25), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line  
3 thirteen (13) after the word "aided" the following: "; and may  
4 purchase uniforms for members of the school band and other school  
5 instrumental or vocal music groups".

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred eighty point twelve (280.12),  
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

3 "The board of school directors in any school district may  
4 provide by resolution that the teaching of instrumental music in  
5 addition to vocal music shall be required to be offered to students  
6 attending any public school within the district and may provide  
7 students who are members of a band and other instrumental or vocal  
8 music groups which are a part of the school activities with any  
9 uniforms deemed necessary."

## SENATE FILE 139

1 Amend Senate File 139, section 2, line 9, by  
2 striking all after the word "necessary" and  
3 adding thereto the following: "provided that at  
4 least half of the cost of said uniforms is  
5 provided from funds not raised by taxation."
