# SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

*passed on file 2/12 on calendar 7/12*  
A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to the sessions of the General Assembly.

*Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of  
2 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section two (2) of Article three (III) of the Constitution  
4 of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed and the following adopted  
5 in lieu thereof:

6 "Section 2. The General Assembly shall meet in session on  
7 the second Monday of January of each year. The Governor of the  
8 State may convene the General Assembly by proclamation in the  
9 interim."

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution  
2 of the State of Iowa is hereby referred to the general assembly  
3 to be chosen at the next general election for members of the  
4 general assembly and the secretary of state is directed to cause  
5 the same to be published for three (3) consecutive months previous  
6 to the date of said election as provided by law.
