A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the movement of mobile homes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point four
2 hundred sixty-seven (321.467), Code 1966, is hereby amended
3 as follows:
4 1. By striking lines thirty-eight (38) through sixty
5 (60) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
6 "or assembled within this state. Provided further that
7 the state highway commission or local authorities may in
8 their discretion issue annual or single trip permits for the
9 movement of mobile homes for unlimited distances. Annual
10 permits may be issued for mobile homes not to exceed twelve
11 (12) feet five (5) inches in width, an overall combination
12 length of seventy-five (75) feet zero (0) inches with an
13 actual mobile home length of sixty (60) feet. Single trip
14 permits may be issued for mobile homes not to exceed twelve
15 (12) feet five (5) inches in width, an overall combination
16 length of eighty-three (83) feet zero (0) inches with an
17 actual mobile home length of not more than sixty-eight (68)
18 feet zero (0) inches. The height of mobile homes shall not
19 exceed thirteen (13) feet ten (10) inches. Such permits may
20 be issued to financially responsible applicants who are
21 experienced in the movement of such loads. Movement of such
22 loads shall be permitted by a one and one-half (1 1/2) ton
23 or larger truck having dual wheels, at speeds of forty-five

24 (45) miles an hour or the established speed limit whichever
25 is lower. Movement under permit shall be permitted during
26 daylight hours but no movement shall be permitted on
27 Saturdays, Sundays or holidays. Travel on the interstate
28 system shall be consistent with the federal requirements for
29 such system. The respective highway departments may prescribe
30 reasonable conditions for the movement designed to promote the
31 public safety and convenience. Provided fur-".

32 2. By inserting in line sixty-three (63) after the word
33 "officials," the words "or in the interest of the economic
34 welfare of the state,".

35 3. By inserting in line sixty-eight (68) after the word
36 "emergency" the words ", economic,".

1 Amend Senate File 418 as follows:

2 1. Amend the title by inserting after the word "homes"
3 the words "and house boats".

4 2. Amend section one (1) by inserting after the word
5 "homes" in lines nine (9), ten (10), fourteen (14),
6 and eighteen (18) the words "and house boats".

7 3. Further amend section one (1) by inserting after the
8 word "home" in lines thirteen (13) and seventeen (17)
9 the words "or house boat".

1 Senate File 418 is hereby amended as follows:

2 1. Amend section one (1) by inserting in line thirty-one
3 (31) after the word "convenience." the following:

4 "Provided further that the state highway commission or
5 local authorities may also issue annual trip permits for the
6 movement of truck trailers manufactured or assembled in this
7 state that exceed the maximum length specified in section
8 three hundred twenty-one point four hundred fifty-seven
9 (321.457) of the Code. Movement of such truck trailers shall
10 be solely for the purpose of delivery from the point of manu-
11 facture or assembly to a point outside the state, shall be
12 only on roadways of twenty-four (24) feet or more in width or
13 on four-lane highways, shall be on the most direct route neces-
14 sary for delivery, and shall display the special plates
15 designated in section three hundred twenty-one point fifty-
16 seven (321.57) of the Code. All truck trailers being delivered
17 shall be unladen. Movement of truck trailers under permit for
18 delivery shall be at a speed of forty-five (45) miles an hour
19 or the established speed limit whichever is lower, shall be
20 permitted during daylight hours only, and no movement shall be
21 permitted on Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays. No vehicle or
22 combination of two (2) or more vehicles inclusive of front
23 and rear bumpers, including towing units, involved in the
24 delivery of truck trailers shall exceed sixty-five (65) feet
25 in length. All such vehicles or combinations shall be dis-
26 tinctly marked on both the front and rear of the unit in such
27 manner as the commissioner shall designate to indicate that
28 the vehicles or combinations are being moved for delivery
29 purposes only."

30 2. Amend the title by inserting in line one (1) after the
31 word "homes" the words "and truck trailers".
