A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize the incorporation of the town of Lucas, Lucas county, Iowa, the election of its officers, the passage and adoption of its ordinances and resolutions and all acts done by the officials of said town while acting as such.

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen as to the legality of the incorporation of the town of Lucas, Lucas county, Iowa, and the acts of its officers thereunder, the election of its officers, the passage and adoption of its ordinances and resolutions, the signing of the same by the proper officers, and the recording and publication thereof; NOW THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That the incorporation of the town of Lucas,
2 Lucas county, Iowa, the election of its officers, the pass-
3 age and adoption of its resolutions and ordinances, the sign-
4 ing of the same by its proper officers or the lack thereof,
5 and all the official acts done or undertaken by said council
6 and the officers of said town, of a civil administrative char-
7 acter authorized under the laws of the state to be done or
8 undertaken by like officers, are hereby validated, legalized,
9 established and the same are declared to be valid and binding,
10 with the same force and effect as though there had been in all
11 respects strict compliance with the law. Nothing in this Act
12 shall in any manner affect any litigation which may be pend-
13 ing.

1 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
3 tion in The Monroe County News, a newspaper published in Albia,
4 Iowa, and the Chariton Herald-Patriot, a newspaper published
5 in Chariton, Iowa, without expense to the state.
