A BILL FOR

An Act relating to state communications and educational radio and television.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. It is the intent of the general assembly in
2 providing for state communications, that an educa-
3 tional radio and television facility, including provision for
4 closed circuit television, be established to serve
5 the entire state, and that communications of state government
6 be coordinated to effect maximum practical consolidation and
7 joint use of communications services.

1 Sec. 2. When used in this Act, unless the context other-
2 wise requires:

3 a. "State communications" means a system
4 to serve communications needs of state departments
5 and agencies.

6 b. "Division" means the communications division of the
7 state comptroller's office.

8 c. "Council" means the communications advisory
9 council.

10 d. "Radio and television facility" means transmitters,
11 towers, studios, and all necessary associated equipment for
12 educational broadcasting.

13 e. "Board" means the educational radio and television facility
14 board.

1 Sec. 3. The administration of state communications

2 shall be vested in the office of the state comptroller.
3 A director of the division shall be appointed by and serve
4 at the pleasure of the comptroller with the approval of the
5 governor. The director shall not be included in the merit
6 councils, boards, and commissions created by this Act shall system. All
7 for administrative purposes, in the office of the state be placed,
8 comptroller shall fix the director's compensation if it is not comptroller. The

1 Sec. 4. The director shall promulgate rules and regula-
2 tions relating to state communications in accordance
3 with the provisions of this Act. The director shall also
4 adopt and provide for standard communications procedures and
5 policies to be used by all departments and agencies of state
6 government.

7 Communications activities of departments of state govern-
8 ment which affect the overall operation of state communi-
9 cations shall fall within the administrative jurisdiction
10 of the division for review and action upon request from any
11 department of state government.

12 Communications activities which are operational and the
13 responsibility of a particular department of state government
14 shall continue to fall within the administrative jurisdiction
15 of that department of state government and be financed through
16 its appropriations.

17 The communications division and the state educational radio
18 and television facility board shall coordinate their activities
19 to achieve the maximum possible cooperation and effective use
20 of the available services and facilities.

1 Sec. 5. The state communications advisory council shall
2 provide guidance to the division in the development, admin-
3 istration, unification and standardization of communication services
4 to meet normal and emergency requirements of all state depart-
5 ments. The council shall consist of the following persons

6 or their designated representatives:

- 7 1. The superintendent of public instruction.
- 8 2. The commissioner of public safety.
- 9 3. The adjutant general.
- 10 4. The chairman of the Iowa highway commission.
- 11 5. The president of the state board of regents.
- 12 6. The chairman of the state board of control.
- 13 7. The chairman of the state educational radio and televi-
- 14 sion facility board.

1 Sec. 6. There is hereby created a state educational radio
2 and television facility board for the purpose of planning, es-
3 tablishing, and operating an educational radio and television
4 facility and such other communications services as may prove
5 necessary in aid of the accomplishment of the educational ob-
6 jectives of the state.

1 Sec. 7. The board shall be composed of nine (9) members
2 who shall be selected in the following manner:

3 1. Three (3) members shall be appointed by the state board
4 of public instruction from its own membership or from the per-
5 sonnel of the state department of public instruction.

6 2. Three (3) members shall be appointed by the state board
7 of regents from its own membership or from among its employees
8 or employees of institutions under the jurisdiction of the
9 board.

10 3. Three (3) members shall be appointed by the governor,
11 at least one (1) of whom shall be from a regionally accredited
12 private four-year college or university.

1 Sec. 8. Terms of office for members of the board shall be
2 for three (3) years. Initial appointments in each of the three
3 (3) categories of appointment provided in section seven (7)
4 of this Act shall be for one (1), two (2), and three (3) years
5 respectively, and thereafter all appointments, except appoint-
6 ments to fill a vacancy shall be for a term of three (3) years.
7 Terms shall commence on July 1 of the year of the appointment.

1 Sec. 9. A vacancy on the board shall be as defined in sec-
2 tion two hundred seventy-seven point twenty-nine (277.29),
3 Code 1966, insofar as applicable. Termination of qualifying
4 employment, under any of the categories of appointment speci-
5 fied in section seven (7) of this Act shall also create a
6 vacancy. Vacancies shall be filled by the authority making
7 the original appointment of the person whose membership has
8 been vacated.

1 Sec. 10. The council and board shall each elect from their
2 respective memberships a chairman and vice-chairman who shall
3 each serve for one (1) year and who may be reelected. Member-
4 ship on the council or board shall not constitute holding a
5 public office and members shall not be required to take and
6 file oaths of office before serving. No member shall be dis-
7 qualified from holding any public office or employment by
8 reason of his appointment or membership on either the council
9 or the board nor shall any member forfeit any such office or
10 employment by reason of his appointment to the council or board,
11 notwithstanding the provisions of any general, special or local
12 law, ordinance or city charter.

1 Sec. 11. The members of both the council and the board shall
2 serve without compensation but shall be entitled to travel and
3 actual and necessary expenses involved in attending meetings
4 and in the performance of their duties.

1 Sec. 12. Both the council and the board shall meet separately
2 at least four (4) times each year and shall hold special meet-
3 ings when called by the appropriate chairman or in the absence
4 of the chairman by the vice-chairman or by the chairman upon
5 written request of four (4) members. Both the council and the
6 board shall establish procedures and requirements with respect
7 to quorum, place and conduct of meetings.

1 Sec. 13. The board shall appoint at least two (2) advisory
2 committees as follows:

- 3 1. Advisory committee on general operations and policy.
- 4 2. Advisory committee on curricula and educational matters.

5 shall be without reference to political party affiliation,
6 religious beliefs, sex, marital status, race, color, or na-
7 tional origin. The total amount of compensation for employees
8 shall be subject to the limitation of the appropriation and
9 other funds lawfully available.

1 Sec. 19. Nothing in this Act shall prohibit local boards of
2 education from owning, operating, improving, and maintaining
3 educational radio and television stations and transmitters now in
4 existence and operation. Local boards of education are hereby
5 empowered and authorized to enter into such agreements with the
6 state educational radio and television facility board as are con-
7 templated in section fifteen (15) of this Act.

5 Duties of said advisory committees, and such additional ad-
6 visory committees as the board may from time to time appoint,
7 shall be specified in rules of internal management adopted by
8 the board.

1 Sec. 14. The board, the governor, or the state comptroller
2 may apply for and accept federal or nonfederal gifts, loans,
3 or grants of funds and to use the same to pay all or part of
4 the cost of carrying out any project under the provisions of
5 this Act.

1 Sec. 15. The board shall have power to purchase or lease
2 property, equipment, and services and to improve same for
3 proper educational communications uses, and to dispose of
4 equipment when not necessary for their purposes. ^{property and}

1 Sec. 16. The board shall make applications for all neces-
2 sary channels, frequencies, licenses, and permits in aid of
3 carrying out their purposes.

1 Sec. 17. The board and division may arrange for joint use of
2 available services and facilities.

3 No charge or fee shall be paid by the state of Iowa or any of
4 boards, commissions, agencies, and departments for any ^{its}
5 installation of any communication equipment, or rate for the use
6 thereof, unless the Iowa commerce commission shall upon hearing
7 affirmatively find that such charge, fee, and rate is fair and
8 reasonable. In the event the charge, fee or rate is found by the
9 commerce commission to be unfair or unreasonable, and the
10 public utility or person, firm, or corporation that desires to
11 provide such equipment and services will not provide such equipment
12 and services for the charge, fee, and rate approved, the communica-
13 tions advisory council may make whatever other arrangements for
14 communications services as are necessary.

1 Sec. 18. The board shall appoint a director who shall not be
2 included in the Iowa merit system and fix his compensation if it is
3 not otherwise provided by law. All appointments of personnel
4 needed to administer this Act
