A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the establishment of an advisory committee on elementary and secondary school approval standards.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred fifty-seven point
2 twenty-five, (257.25), Code 1966, is hereby amended by
3 adding thereto the following new subsection:

4 "There is hereby established a state advisory committee
5 on approval standards for elementary and secondary schools
6 which shall consist of sixteen (16) members. Members of
7 the committee shall be appointed by the governor and shall
8 include:

- 9 1. An elementary school principal.
- 10 2. A high school principal.
- 11 3. A local superintendent of schools.
- 12 4. A currently employed school teacher.
- 13 5. Three (3) representatives of non-public schools.
- 14 6. Two (2) members of local boards of education.
- 15 7. A county or merged county area superintendent of
16 schools.
- 17 8. Two (2) representatives of parent organizations.
- 18 9. Two (2) representatives of higher education, one (1)
19 of whom shall represent private and one (1) public colleges
20 or universities.
- 21 10. Two (2) members to represent the board of public
22 instruction.

23 The members of the state advisory committee shall serve

24 for terms of four (4) years but the sixteen (16) initial
25 appointees shall serve as follows: Eight (8) members shall
26 serve from the date of appointment until June 30, 1969 and
27 eight (8) members shall serve from the date of the appointment
28 until June 30, 1971. Any vacancy on the committee shall be
29 filled for the unexpired term of the vacancy in the same
30 manner as the original appointment. Members of the committee
31 shall serve without compensation but shall be allowed actual
32 and necessary expenses while engaged in official duties.

33 Prior to August 1 of each year, the advisory committee
34 shall meet and organize. The committee shall annually elect
35 a chairman and such other officers as committee members deem
36 necessary. The chairman of the committee shall be responsible
37 for calling meetings of the advisory committee. Advisory
38 committee members shall meet at least four (4) times a year
39 and at such other times as the chairman or the state
40 superintendent deems necessary.

41 The advisory committee shall advise the state board on the
42 adoption of standards for public and non-public elementary and
43 secondary schools and on other matters relating to approval of
44 such schools."

1 Amend Senate File 753 as follows:

2 1. By inserting in line four (4) of section one (1) after
3 the word, "established" the words, "within the department of
4 public instruction".
