A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969, to the board of control for salaries, support, maintenance, repairs, replacements, alterations, or equipment of institutions under the board of control, to provide that chapter eight (8), except section eight point five (8.5), Code 1966, shall apply to this Act, and to establish rate of billing for mental health institutes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state of Iowa for each year of the biennium be-
3 ginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969, for the board
4 of control of state institutions for all purposes including
5 salaries, support, maintenance, repairs, replacements, altera-
6 tions, or equipment and miscellaneous purposes for all insti-
7 tutions under the board of control, the sum of thirty-four
8 million eight hundred six thousand eight hundred twenty
9 (34,806,820) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
10 to be used for the following purposes, to wit:

1 Sec. 2. The budget of total expenditures for each institu-
 2 tion under the control of the board of control during the
 3 biennium shall not exceed the state appropriation for each in-
 4 stitution set forth in this Act, except that the gross salary
 5 expenditure shall be adjusted by the maintenance recovery in
 6 arriving at the total expenditure.

7 The maintenance recovery is the rental charge to employees
 8 for room, apartment, or house and meals when it is a payroll
 9 deduction and budgeted to the salary appropriation.

10 All other receipts are deposited to the state general fund
 11 and are not to be used by the institution.

1 Sec. 3. All salaries provided for in this Act shall be pay-
 2 able in equal monthly or semi-monthly installments, and shall
 3 be in full compensation for all services except as otherwise
 4 expressly provided and except further that expense allowance
 5 shall be authorized, any ruling of the federal internal revenue
 6 service with respect to the tax status therefor notwithstanding.
 7

1 Sec. 4. No funds appropriated by this Act shall be used for
 2 capital improvements.

1 Sec. 5. Chapter eight (8), Code 1966, shall apply to this
 2 Act, except that employees whose salaries are appropriated in
 3 this Act shall not come under the division of personnel under
 4 section eight point five (8.5), Code 1966.

1 Sec. 6. Where any provisions of the laws of this state are
 2 in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall
 3 govern for the biennium.

1 Sec. 7. The mental health institutes' daily per diem as
 2 determined by section two hundred thirty point twenty (230.20)

3 of the Code shall be billed at eighty (80) percent for the
4 biennium.

1 Sec. 8. The state hospital schools' daily per diem as
2 determined by section two hundred twenty-two point seventy-
3 three (222.73) of the Code shall be billed at eighty (80)
4 percent for the biennium.
