SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to the sessions of the General Assembly.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
2 of the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section two (2) of Article three (III) of the Constitution
4 of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed and the following
5 adopted in lieu thereof:

6 "Section 2. The General Assembly shall meet in session
7 on the second Monday of January of each year. The Governor
8 of the State may convene the General Assembly by proclamation
9 in the interim."

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been
2 adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-first (61st) General
3 Assembly, thereafter duly published, and now adopted and
4 agreed to by the Sixty-second (62nd) General Assembly in
5 this Joint Resolution, shall be submitted to the people
6 of the State of Iowa at the general election in November
7 of the year nineteen hundred sixty-eight (1968) in the
8 manner required by the Constitution of the State of Iowa
9 and the laws of the State of Iowa.

1 Amend Senate Joint Resolution 4 as follows:

2 1. Amend section one (1) by adding the following
3 after the word "interim." in line 9: "In even-numbered
4 years the session shall be limited to consideration of
5 the budget, the production, distribution and appropria-
6 tion of revenue, review and revision of the tax
7 structure, legislation designed to meet emergencies,
8 and such other legislation involving subject matters
9 authorized for consideration by the General Assembly
10 under rules adopted by a majority of not less than
11 two-thirds of its elected members of each house as
12 authorized by law."

13 2. Further amend by striking all of section two (2)
14 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

15 "Sec. 2. The foregoing amendment to the Constitution
16 of the State of Iowa is hereby referred to the general
17 assembly to be chosen at the next general election for
18 members of the general assembly and the secretary of
19 state is directed to cause the same to be published
20 for three (3) consecutive months previous to the date
21 of said election as provided by law."
