## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to compensation for members of the General Assembly.

*Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution  
2 of the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section twenty-five (25) of Article three (III) of the  
4 Constitution of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed and the  
5 following adopted in lieu thereof:

6 "Section 25. Each member of the General Assembly shall  
7 receive such compensation and allowances for expenses as shall  
8 be fixed by law but no General Assembly shall have the power  
9 to increase compensation and allowances effective prior to  
10 the convening of the next General Assembly following the session  
11 in which any increase is adopted."

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been  
2 adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-first (61st) General Assembly,  
3 thereafter duly published, and now adopted and agreed to by  
4 the Sixty-second (62nd) General Assembly in this Joint Resolution,  
5 shall be submitted to the people of the State of Iowa at the  
6 general election in November of the year nineteen hundred  
7 sixty-eight (1968) in the manner required by the Constitution  
8 of the State of Iowa and the laws of the State of Iowa.

Senate

1 Amend S.J.R. 10 as follows:  
2 1. Amend section one (1) by striking lines three (3)  
3 through eleven (11) and inserting in lieu thereof the follow-  
4 ing:  
5 "Section twenty-five (25) of Article three (III) of the  
6 Constitution of the State of Iowa is amended by adding the  
7 following paragraph:  
8 'Members of the General Assembly shall receive such compen-  
9 sation for mileage each week during a session in going to and  
10 returning from the place where the General Assembly is held by  
11 the nearest traveled route but not to exceed once each week.'"  
12 2. Amend section two (2) by striking all of section two(2)  
13 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
14 "Sec. 2. The foregoing amendment to the Constitution of the  
15 State of Iowa is hereby referred to the General Assembly to be  
16 chosen at the next general election for members of the General  
17 Assembly and the Secretary of State is directed to cause the  
18 same to be published previous to the date of said election as  
provided by law."

17 election as provided by law."
