## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to voting requirements.

*Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of  
2 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section one (1) of Article two (II) of the Constitution of  
4 the State of Iowa as amended by Amendment One (1) of the  
5 Amendments of 1868 is hereby repealed and the following adopted  
6 in lieu thereof:

7 "Every citizen of the United States who has attained the  
8 age of twenty-one (21) and who shall preceding the election  
9 have been a resident, as required by law, of this state and  
10 of the county where vote is claimed, shall be entitled to vote  
11 at all elections now and hereafter authorized by law."

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution  
2 of the state of Iowa is hereby referred to the general assembly  
3 to be chosen at the next general election for members of the  
4 general assembly and the secretary of state is directed to  
5 cause the same to be published for three (3) consecutive months  
6 before the date of said election as provided by law.
