SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing amendments to the Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to the election and terms of state officers.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The following amendments to the Constitution of
2 the State of Iowa are hereby proposed:

3 Amendment 1. Section twenty-two (22) of Article four (IV)
4 of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is repealed and the
5 following adopted in lieu thereof:

6 "Sec. 22. A Secretary of State, Auditor of State and
7 Treasurer of State, shall be elected by the qualified elec-
8 tors at such time and for term, and to perform such duties
9 as may be provided by law."

10 Amendment 2. Section twelve (12) of Article five (V) of
11 the Constitution is repealed and the following adopted in lieu
12 thereof:

13 "Sec. 12. The General Assembly shall provide, by law, for
14 the election of an Attorney General by the people at the same
15 time that the Governor is elected, whose term of office shall
16 be four (4) years, and until his successor shall have been
17 elected and qualified."

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendments to the Con-
2 stitution of the State of Iowa are hereby referred to the
3 General Assembly to be chosen at the next general election
4 for members of the General Assembly, and the Secretary of

5 State is directed to cause the same to be published for three
6 (3) consecutive months previous to the date of said election
7 as provided by law.

1 Sec. 3. The foregoing proposed amendments, if approved
2 in identical form, by the General Assembly chosen at the
3 general election for members of the General Assembly to
4 be held in the year nineteen hundred sixty-eight (1968),
5 shall be submitted to electors of the state at a special
6 election to be held on the Tuesday next, after the first
7 Monday in November, in the year nineteen hundred sixty-nine
8 (1969) in the manner required by the Constitution and laws
9 of the State of Iowa.
