A BILL FOR

1 An Act to permit counties to become associated with the Iowa
2 state association of counties.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section three hundred thirty-two point three
5 (332.3), Code 1966, as amended by chapters two hundred ninety-
6 two (292) and two hundred ninety-three (293), Acts of the
7 Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby further amended by
8 adding the following new subsections:

9 1. "To provide for membership in the Iowa state associa-
10 tion of counties, a nonprofit corporation organized under
11 chapter five hundred four A (504A) for the purpose of main-
12 taining a permanent organization to secure cooperation among
13 the several counties and their officers in their effort to
14 procure better and more efficient methods of government."

15 2. "To authorize attendance at schools of instruction by
16 county officers, appointees, and employees at such times
17 as they are called by the association and to authorize atten-
18 dance at the annual meeting of the association by the duly
19 certified representatives of each organization which is affil-
20 iated with the association."

21 3. "To appropriate from the county general fund necessary
22 funds to provide membership in the Iowa state association of
23 counties, provided that the method of assessment shall be
24 established on a basis whereby each county shall pay not to
25 exceed one cent per capita and one-hundredth of one mill of

1 each county's valuation. The total assessment collected from
 2 all the member counties shall not exceed seventy-five thousand
 3 dollars per annum. In the event that more than seventy-five
 4 thousand dollars per annum is collected, the excess shall be
 5 refunded proportionately to the counties from which payment
 6 is received. In addition, counties may pay out of the general
 7 fund the actual expenses of one person from each office or
 8 agency of the county attending schools of instruction and the
 9 annual meeting of the association. The association shall keep
 10 and make such accounts as shall be required by the auditor of
 11 state, which accounts shall be audited annually and published
 12 in the auditor's biennial report."

13 Sec. 2. Section three hundred forty-three point twelve
 14 (343.12), Code 1966, is hereby repealed.

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 366

This bill allows county supervisors to authorize joining the Iowa State Association of Counties, to authorize employees to attend certain schools, and authorize the expenditure of funds for such purposes.
