A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the penalty for the deliberate littering
- 2 of highways.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point three
- 5 hundred sixty-nine (321.369), Code 1966, is hereby amended
- 6 by adding thereto the following:
- 7 "The court, in lieu of or in addition to any other sentence
- 8 imposed, may direct and supervise a labor of litter gathering,
- 9 including, but not limited to, the litter connected with the
- 10 particular violation."

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 461

This bill allows the court to impose the penalty stated in section 321.482, Code 1966, which is a fine of \$100 or imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or to impose a sentence of court supervised litter gathering, or to impose both penalties.
