## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act reorganizing the executive functions of state government  
2 by creating an executive department, a division of general  
3 services, an office of planning and programming, placing  
4 other agencies within the executive department, providing  
5 for establishment of a division of data processing, and  
6 delegating certain executive duties.
- 7 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 8 Section 1. There is hereby created an executive department  
9 of state government. This department shall be under the con-  
10 trol of and administered by the governor. The executive  
11 department shall contain the governor's personal staff, and  
12 shall be organized into the governor's office, state comp-  
13 troller, division of general services, office of planning and  
14 programming, arts council, civil rights commission, commission  
15 on aging, higher education facilities commission, and all  
16 agencies established pursuant to section seven point nine  
17 (7.9) of the Code.
- 18 Sec. 2. For purposes of this Act, unless the context other-  
19 wise requires:
- 20 1. "Federal aid" means all kinds and types of federal  
21 grants, assistance, loans, and any other federal help, whether  
22 or not any state or local funds are required to match or con-  
23 tribute toward the costs of the program for which the aid is  
24 available.
- 25 2. "Private aid" means all kinds and types of grants,

1 assistance, loans, and any other help available from nonprofit  
2 corporations, foundations, and all private or nongovernmental  
3 sources, whether or not any state or local funds are required  
4 to match or contribute toward the costs of the program for  
5 which the aid is available.

6 3. "State agency" means all departments, boards, commis-  
7 sions, and agencies of state government, or any subunit of  
8 these, in this state.

9 4. "Local governments" means all counties, municipal cor-  
10 porations, and political subdivisions of this state.

11 Sec. 3. The governor shall assign to existing departments  
12 or divisions or create a new department or agency within the  
13 executive department for all agencies now in existence or  
14 hereafter created pursuant to section seven point nine (7.9)  
15 of the Code, and when any agencies cease to be useful or bene-  
16 ficial to the state of Iowa, the governor shall abolish them  
17 by executive order.

18 Sec. 4. The state comptroller shall have the following  
19 powers and duties in addition to others prescribed by law:

20 1. Establish uniform budget asking procedures and analyze  
21 and make recommendations on departmental budget requests.

22 2. Prepare the governor's budget.

23 3. Forecast revenue estimates.

24 4. Supervise budget execution.

25 5. Conduct management surveys.

26 6. Develop, administer, supervise, and maintain a state  
27 program for records management.

28 7. Develop, administer, supervise, and maintain a state  
29 policy and procedural manuals that shall be used and followed  
30 by all state agencies, boards, commissions, and departments in  
31 their official communications and relations with the division  
32 of budget and accounting.

33 8. Establish, administer, and supervise a system of fiscal  
34 control.

35 9. Develop, administer, supervise, and promulgate a uniform

1 state system of accounting.

2 10. Provide for preaudit of payments.

3 11. Maintain central control accounts.

4 12. Maintain payroll and related records.

5 13. Render financial statements.

6 14. Centrally disburse state funds, conduct special studies,  
7 and prepare reports requested by the governor.

8 15. Otherwise assist in development and execution of state  
9 fiscal policy.

10 The state comptroller may, by rule and regulation, provide  
11 that the budgets of any licensing boards not within another  
12 department, be compiled and submitted as a single budget. The  
13 budgets of such licensing boards shall be compiled and sub-  
14 mitted in accordance with the state comptroller's ruling. The  
15 appropriation made by the general assembly for such licensing  
16 boards shall be contained in a single appropriation bill. The  
17 state comptroller may further assign or reassign duties, powers,  
18 and responsibilities from one division of his department to  
19 another or assign additional duties, powers, and responsibili-  
20 ties assigned to him by law to an appropriate division or por-  
21 tion of his department.

22 Sec. 5. The state comptroller may establish a division of  
23 data processing. When it is determined under the merit system  
24 that a director of this division is warranted, he shall be  
25 appointed by the state comptroller. The director shall be  
26 educated and experienced in the modern techniques involved in  
27 the preparation, storage, and analysis of data. He shall  
28 establish a data processing service center for the benefit of  
29 the various state agencies, and provide programming and sys-  
30 tems analysis services, and other beneficial services.

31 Sec. 6. There is hereby established within the executive  
32 department a division of general services which will be con-  
33 trolled and administered by a director appointed by the  
34 governor. The director of general services shall be educated  
35 and experienced in the areas of institutional purchasing and

1 maintenance of property and equipment, and qualified to admin-  
2 ister and control a large number of varied and different depart-  
3 ments. He shall have the following duties and powers:

4 1. Establish and develop, in cooperation with the various  
5 state agencies, a system of uniform standards and specifica-  
6 tions for purchasing. As soon as the system is developed, all  
7 items of general use shall be purchased through this division.

8 2. Provide for the proper maintenance and protection of  
9 state buildings and equipment.

10 3. Arrange, when necessary and after approval by the  
11 executive council, for the leasing or rental of all office  
12 space for state agencies from private enterprise, and assign  
13 space within all state buildings to state agencies.

14 4. Manage the state automotive fleet, and establish and  
15 administer policies and procedures for the efficient acquisi-  
16 tion, maintenance, operation, disposal, and use of all state  
17 vehicles.

18 5. Provide for a system of centralized printing and dupli-  
19 cating.

20 6. Provide for an adequate, efficient, and proper mail and  
21 messenger service.

22 7. Establish and operate a center for storage of inactive  
23 state records, to include microfilming if warranted.

24 8. Establish and administer a state surplus personal prop-  
25 erty reutilization program and serve as the state agency for  
26 the federal surplus property program.

27 Sec. 7. All of the powers, duties, and responsibilities  
28 lodged in the state printing board, the superintendent of  
29 printing, the superintendent of public buildings and grounds,  
30 the state car dispatcher, the state war surplus commodities  
31 program, and the administrative functions of the capitol plan-  
32 ning commission are hereby transferred to and lodged in the  
33 division of general services in the executive department. The  
34 armory board shall be attached to and utilize the services of  
35 the division of general services, when practical; however, it

1 shall continue to perform the duties and functions assigned to  
2 it by law.

3     Sec. 8. Orderly growth of the state of Iowa is accomplished  
4 by systematic development and enhancement of the state's human,  
5 educational, agricultural, economic, transportation, cultural,  
6 and natural resources. Adequate present and future planning  
7 of programs to accomplish such development and enhancement and  
8 to provide for the effective and efficient implementation of  
9 such programs is vital. For these reasons, there is hereby  
10 established within the executive department an office of plan-  
11 ning and programming. This office shall insure that the  
12 separate state agencies engage in present and future systematic  
13 planning of programs to develop and enhance all of the re-  
14 sources of this state. This office shall be in charge of a  
15 director who shall be appointed by the governor to serve at  
16 his pleasure. The salary of the director shall be established  
17 by the Iowa merit employment commission.

18     Sec. 9. The separate state agencies shall have the primary  
19 responsibility for planning present and future programs to  
20 develop and enhance the human, educational, agricultural,  
21 economic, transportation, cultural, and natural resources of  
22 this state that are within their respective jurisdictions.  
23 All present and future programs formulated, adopted, and  
24 implemented by the separate state agencies shall not duplicate  
25 or contradict, in any way, any program already in existence.

26     Sec. 10. Each state agency shall, if required by the  
27 governor, file with the office of planning and programming all  
28 present and future programs formulated and developed by the  
29 agency concerning any matters within its jurisdiction. Each  
30 state agency shall also, if required by the governor, file  
31 with the office of planning and programming all applications,  
32 contracts, agreements, and plans for participation in or for  
33 grants of federal funds under any present or future federal  
34 laws.

35     Sec. 11. All state agencies shall cooperate with the office

1 of planning and programming in the exercise of the powers and  
2 duties conferred upon the office by this Act, and shall furnish  
3 to the office of planning and programming any information,  
4 data, and reports requested.

5 Sec. 12. The governor shall cause to be reviewed, examined,  
6 and evaluated all plans and programs filed with the office of  
7 planning and programming. If it is determined that any two or  
8 more plans or programs are contradictory or duplicate one  
9 another, the governor shall determine which plan or program  
10 shall prevail, and which contradictory items or duplications  
11 shall be deleted from the other plans or programs. The gover-  
12 nor's decision shall be final and binding upon all concerned.  
13 The governor shall also determine whether or not the services  
14 or aid can be rendered from various central area locations  
15 throughout the state. If he determines that services can be  
16 rendered from central area locations, he shall direct that  
17 services be so rendered. The office of planning and program-  
18 ming shall thereafter coordinate with any state agency to  
19 implement the manner in which services shall be rendered from  
20 the various central area locations. The governor shall make  
21 the final decision of how services shall be rendered in the  
22 various central area locations, and his decision shall be final  
23 and binding upon all concerned.

24 Sec. 13. The office of planning and programming shall have  
25 the following powers and duties:

26 1. Prepare comprehensive state-wide recommendations and  
27 plans, as directed by the governor.

28 2. Prepare and submit economic reports appraising the  
29 economic situation of the state, economic growth and develop-  
30 ment of the state as it pertains to employment and income, and  
31 any other economic factors, as directed by the governor.

32 3. Coordinate with the comptroller so that any comprehen-  
33 sive state-wide planning program is consistent with the antici-  
34 pated future income of the state, and so that comprehensive  
35 state-wide programs are consistent, and are included within

- 1 the governor's budget submitted to the general assembly.
- 2 4. Provide technical assistance as requested by the state
- 3 agencies.
- 4 5. Contract with, and enter into interagency agreements
- 5 with the state agencies, to develop present and future plans
- 6 and programs, as requested.
- 7 6. Design, establish, and maintain a state resource center
- 8 for information, data, and other materials which will be
- 9 available on request to local governments, and will be of aid
- 10 in formulating, developing, adopting, and implementing present
- 11 and future programs of state government.
- 12 7. Analyze the quality and quantity of services required
- 13 for the orderly growth of the state, taking into consideration
- 14 the relationship of activities, capabilities, and future plans
- 15 of local units of government, private enterprise, the state
- 16 and federal government, and regional units established under
- 17 any state or federal legislation, and make recommendations to
- 18 the governor and the general assembly for the improvement of
- 19 services.
- 20 8. Work to harmonize the planning activities of all state
- 21 agencies.
- 22 9. Consult with and advise the state agencies concerning
- 23 plans and programs filed with the federal government relative
- 24 to an existing, new, expanded, or amended federal aid program.
- 25 10. Provide assistance to the general assembly or any of
- 26 its committees, when requested.
- 27 11. Apply for, receive, administer, and utilize any federal
- 28 or other funds available for achieving the purpose of this
- 29 Act.
- 30 12. Inquire into the methods of planning and program
- 31 development, and the conduct of the affairs of state government;
- 32 prescribe adequate systems of records for planning and program-
- 33 ming purposes; prescribe the institution of, and the manner of
- 34 use of standards for effective planning and programming; and
- 35 exercise all other powers necessary and proper for the discharge

1 of the powers and duties provided in this Act.

2 13. Develop and submit other plans, programs, and reports,  
3 as directed by the governor.

4 14. Compile and maintain current information on available  
5 and pending federal and private aid programs, and make this  
6 information available to state agencies and to local govern-  
7 ments.

8 15. Provide assistance as requested, to state agencies and  
9 local governments in preparing applications for federal aid or  
10 private aid.

11 16. Compile and maintain current information relating to  
12 the amounts of federal aid and private aid being received and  
13 disbursed by state agencies and local governments.

14 17. Analyze the relations of federal aid and private aid  
15 programs with state and locally financed programs and make  
16 recommendations to state agencies, local governments, the  
17 governor and the general assembly on means of avoiding dupli-  
18 cation of activity and of increasing efficiency in programs  
19 financed by federal aid or private aid.

20 18. Report annually to the governor and to members of the  
21 general assembly on the amounts of federal aid and private aid  
22 received and disbursed by state agencies and local governments  
23 during the preceding fiscal year, the adequacy of programs  
24 financed by federal aid and private aid in this state, and the  
25 types and nature of federal aid and private aid programs in  
26 which state agencies or local governments did not participate.

27 Sec. 14. All state agencies and state officers and all  
28 local governments and local officers shall furnish the office  
29 of planning and programming any information it requests per-  
30 taining to its duties under this Act, and shall assist the  
31 office in carrying out its duties.

32 Sec. 15. Chapter seven (7), Code 1966, is hereby amended  
33 by adding the following new section:

34 "The commission on aging, civil rights commission, higher  
35 education facilities commission, and all agencies now in

1 existence or hereafter established pursuant to section seven  
2 point nine (7.9) of the Code shall be in the executive depart-  
3 ment.”

#### EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 560

This bill provides a reorganization of the executive functions of state government. It establishes the executive department, which is administered and controlled by the governor, and includes the governor's staff, the state comptroller, the division of data processing under the state comptroller, the division of general services, the office of planning and programming, and various other agencies and commissions. The duties of the comptroller, division of general services, and office of planning and programming are spelled out in the bill. Many duties formerly belonging to the executive council are delegated to the director of the division of general services, an office created by this bill.

Prepared in regard to Senate File 560, a bill for an act reorganizing the executive functions of state government by creating an executive department, a division of general services, an office of planning and programming, placing other agencies within the executive department, providing for establishment of a division of data processing, and delegating certain executive duties.

Note: The creation of a Division of General Services could possibly bring about some operating economies by combining the operations of six separate departments. We are unable to pin down those savings at this time.
