1 An Act to increase the compensation of county officers, in-  
2 cluding county attorneys, sheriffs, district court clerks,  
3 and members of the county boards of supervisors.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Section 1. Section three hundred thirty-one point twenty-  
6 two (331.22), Code 1966, as amended by chapter two hundred  
7 ninety-one (291), Section one (1), Acts of the Sixty-second  
8 General Assembly, is hereby repealed and the following enacted  
9 in lieu thereof:

10 "The members of the boards of supervisors shall each be  
11 paid on an annual basis according to the following schedule:

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 611

This bill effects a general increase in the salaries of county boards of supervisors and other county officers, places the members of supervisory boards in all counties below 40,000 on the salary schedule and repeals the provisions for their compensation on a "per diem of work" basis.
