- 1 An Act authorizing capital expenditures by the state highway
- 2 commission from the primary road fund.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the primary
- 5 road fund to the state highway commission the sum of three
- 6 million seven hundred ninety-two thousand seven hundred
- 7 (3,792,700) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
- 8 to be used in the following manner:
- 9 1. Land, construction, improvements, and
- 10 repairs of maintenance facilities\$3,774,700
- 11 2. Rest area storage buildings 18,000
- 12

- 13 Grand total of all appropriations for all
- 14 purposes of this Act for the state highway
- 15 commission\$3,792,700
- 16

- 17 Sec. 2. Commencing with the effective date of this Act, no
- 18 rest areas or rest area buildings shall be established or con-
- 19 structed on an interstate highway at intervals of less than
- 20 sixty miles. The four rest areas or rest area buildings under
- 21 construction on the effective date of this Act shall be com-
- 22 pleted. Such four rest areas are located on interstate highway
- 23 twenty-nine in Monona county, interstate highway twenty-nine in
- 24 Harrison county, interstate highway thirty-five in Clarke county,
- 25 and interstate highway eighty in Pottawattamie county. Rest
- area storage buildings authorized by this Act may be constructed
- at any existing rest area location.

1 Sec. 3. Reasonable maintenance and surveillance of rest area
2 sites and buildings located thereon shall be provided by regular
3 maintenance employees of the state highway commission under the
4 district maintenance engineer in the district where the rest
5 areas are located within the limits of appropriations provided
6 for such purpose.

7 Sec. 4. The state highway commission may obtain and accept
8 any federal grants and funds to the state to be used in connec-
9 tion with the funds appropriated by this Act.

10 Sec. 5. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30,
11 1973 of the appropriation made by this Act shall revert to the
12 primary road fund as of such date.

13 Sec. 6. When the state highway commission has approved a
14 project to be financed with funds authorized in this Act, a
15 description of said project and estimated cost shall be re-
16 ported to the governor and state comptroller for allocation of
17 funds.

18 Sec. 7. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
19 be in full force and effect from and after its final approval
20 and publication in The Maquoketa Community Press, a newspaper
21 published at Maquoketa, Iowa, and the Hardin County Times, a
22 newspaper published at Iowa Falls, Iowa.

EXPLANATION

This Act makes available additional funds for the repair and improvement of a number of maintenance facilities under the jurisdiction of the highway commission. In addition it provides for the construction of storage buildings on rest area sites and limits the construction of rest area sites.
