SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution proposing a constitutional amendment re-
2 lating to qualifications of electors.
3 *Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
4 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
5 of the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:
6 Section one (1) of Article two (II) of the Constitution,
7 as amended in eighteen hundred sixty-eight (1868), is hereby
8 repealed and the following is hereby adopted in lieu thereof:
9 "Section 1. Every citizen of the United States of the age
10 of twenty-one (21) years, who shall have been a resident of
11 this State for such period of time as shall be provided
12 by law and of the county in which he claims his vote for such
13 period of time as shall be provided by law, shall be entitled
14 to vote at all elections which are now or hereafter may be
15 authorized by law. The General Assembly may provide by law
16 for different periods of residence in order to vote for
17 various officers or in order to vote in various elections.
18 The required periods of residence shall not exceed six (6)
19 months in this State and sixty (60) days in the county."
20 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been

1 adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-second General Assembly,
2 thereafter duly published, and now adopted and agreed to by
3 the Sixty-third General Assembly in this Joint Resolution,
4 shall be submitted to the people of the State of Iowa at
5 the general election in November of the year nineteen hundred
6 seventy in the manner required by the Constitution of the State
7 of Iowa and the laws of the State of Iowa.
