A BILL FOR

1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution
2 of the State of Iowa relating to the sessions of the gen-
3 eral assembly.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
6 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

7 Article three (III), section two (2), of the Constitution,
8 as amended in nineteen hundred sixty-eight (1968), is hereby
9 repealed and the following is hereby adopted in lieu thereof:

10 "Section 2. The sessions of the general assembly shall be
11 biennial, and shall commence on the second Monday in January
12 in each odd-numbered year. However, the governor of the state
13 may convene the general assembly by proclamation at any time."

14 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitu-
15 tion of the State of Iowa is hereby referred to the general
16 assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members
17 of the general assembly and the secretary of state is directed
18 to cause the same to be published for three consecutive months
19 previous to the date of said election as provided by law.

EXPLANATION

The joint resolution provides for a return to biennial sessions of the General Assembly.
