HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 A Joint Resolution authorizing the executive council to
2 acquire the Hubbell mansion known as Terrace Hill.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
4 Section 1. The executive council is authorized to accept
5 for the State of Iowa, property described as "Lot One (1)
6 of Polk and Hubbell Park, an addition to the City of Des
7 Moines, Iowa", locally known as Terrace Hill, from the in-
8 come beneficiaries of the Frederick M. Hubbell Estate.
9 The State of Iowa agrees:
10 1. That the mansion will be preserved for not less than
11 twenty-five years.
12 2. That the mansion will be designated and known as "Ter-
13 race Hill".
14 3. That, if requested by the donors at the time of con-
15 veyance, an appropriate plaque, showing the names of the
16 donors, will be installed in the mansion.
17 4. That the State of Iowa signifies its acceptance of
18 the preceding conditions by the passage of this Joint Resolu-
19 tion and the transmittal of a certified copy of this Joint
20 Resolution to the income beneficiaries of the Frederick M.
21 Hubbell Estate.
22 Sec. 2. The executive council shall, under the provisions
23 of section nineteen point twenty-nine (19.29) of the Code,
24 maintain Terrace Hill. Final use of the property shall be
25 determined by the General Assembly.
