## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to registration fees for snowmobiles and the  
2 disposition of the fees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one G point four  
2 (321G.4), unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1971, is amended  
3 as follows:

4 The owner of such snowmobile shall file an application  
5 for registration with the appropriate county recorder on forms  
6 provided by the commission. The application shall be com-  
7 pleted and signed by the owner of the snowmobile and shall  
8 be accompanied by a fee of ~~six~~ twelve dollars and a writing  
9 fee of fifty cents. Proof of payment of Iowa sales or use  
10 tax must accompany all applications for registration. Upon  
11 receipt of the application in approved form accompanied by  
12 the required fees, the county recorder shall enter the same  
13 upon his records and shall issue to the applicant a pocket-  
14 size registration certificate. The certificate shall be exe-  
15 cuted in triplicate, one copy to be delivered to the owner,  
16 one copy to the commission, and one copy to be retained on  
17 file by the county recorder. The registration certificate  
18 shall bear the number awarded to such snowmobile and the name  
19 and address of the owner. The registration certificate shall  
20 be carried either in the snowmobile or on the person of the  
21 operator of such machine when in use.

22 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one G point six  
23 (321G.6), unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1971, is amended  
24 as follows:

25 After the first day of January any unregistered snowmobile  
26 may be registered for the remainder of the current registra-  
27 tion period and for the subsequent registration period in  
28 one transaction. The fee shall be ~~three~~ six dollars for the  
29 remainder of the current period, in addition to the regis-  
30 tration fee of ~~six~~ twelve dollars for the subsequent year  
31 beginning May 1, and a writing fee of fifty cents. Registra-  
32 tion certificates and numbers may be renewed upon application  
33 of the owner in the same manner as provided for in securing  
34 the original registration.

35 Sec. 3. Section three hundred twenty-one G point seven

1 (321G.7), Code 1971, is amended as follows:

2 321G.7 DISPOSITION OF FEES TO-CONSERVATION-FUND. All  
3 One-half of the fees collected from the registration of  
4 snowmobiles shall be forwarded by the county recorder to the  
5 commission for remission to the treasurer of state, who shall  
6 place such money in the state conservation fund. The fees  
7 collected credited to the state conservation fund shall be  
8 appropriated by the general assembly to the commission solely  
9 for their its use. The remainder of the registration fees  
10 collected shall be transmitted to the county treasurer and  
11 credited by him to the general fund of the county.

12 Sec. 4. Chapter three hundred twenty-one G (321G), Code  
13 1971, is amended by adding the following new section:

14 "The registration fees paid on snowmobiles as provided  
15 in this chapter shall be in lieu of any personal property  
16 taxation to which the snowmobile might otherwise be subject."

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides for the increase of the annual regis-  
19 tration fee for snowmobiles from six dollars to twelve dol-  
20 lars. The fee for registration after January 1 but before  
21 May 1 is increased from three dollars to six dollars.

22 The bill also provides that the new registration fees be di-  
23 vided equally between the state conservation fund and the  
24 general fund of the county in which the fees are collected.

25 The payment of the registration fee exempts the snowmo-  
26 bile from personal property taxation.

3 1. Page 2, line 23, by striking the words and figure  
4 "paragraph two (2)" and the word "is" and inserting  
5 in lieu thereof the words and figures "paragraphs one  
6 (1), two (2), and three (3)" and the word "are".  
7 2. Page 2, after line 24, by inserting the following:  
8 Every registration certificate and number issued  
9 shall expire at midnight ~~April-30~~ December 31, unless  
10 sooner terminated or discontinued in accordance with  
11 the provisions of this chapter. After the first day  
12 of January ~~September~~ each year, any unregistered  
13 snowmobile and renewals of registration may be so  
14 registered for the subsequent year beginning May January 1.  
15 3. Page 2, line 25, by striking the word "January"  
16 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "January  
17 September".  
18 4. Page 2, line 31, by striking the word "May" and  
19 inserting in lieu thereof the words "May January".  
20 5. Page 2, after line 34, by inserting the following:  
21 If the application for registration for the subsequent  
22 year is not made before May January 1 of each year,  
23 the applicant shall be charged a penalty of one dollar  
24 for each six month's delinquency, or any portion thereof.  
25 6. Page 1, line 1, amend the title by inserting  
26 after the word "fees", the words "and registration  
27 dates".
