A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to fish and game licenses and fees.
 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1),
2 lines one (1) to forty-seven (47), inclusive, Code 1971, is
3 amended as follows:

4 Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, no person
5 shall fish, trap, hunt, pursue, catch, kill or take in any
6 manner, or use or have possession of, or sell or transport
7 all or any portion of any wild animal, bird, game or fish,
8 the protection and regulation of which is desirable for the
9 conservation of the resources of the state, without first
10 procuring a license or certificate so to do and the payment
11 of a fee as follows:

12 Fishing licenses:

13 All persons legal residents of the state,
14 except as otherwise provided~~3.00~~ 4.00

15 All persons legal residents of the state and
16 sixty-five years of age or older, except as
17 otherwise provided 3.00

18 No person, resident or nonresident, required to have a fish-
19 ing license, shall fish for trout in waters designated by the
20 state conservation commission as "trout waters" without having
21 a special license stamp affixed to his fishing license.

22 Special trout fishing license stamp ~~3.00~~ 5.00

23 The proceeds from the sale of this stamp shall be used ex-
24 clusively to restock the "trout waters" designated by the state
25 conservation commission.

26 Hunting licenses:

27 All persons legal residents of the state,
28 except as otherwise provided ~~3.00~~ 5.00

29 All persons legal residents of the state and
30 sixty-five years of age or older, except as
31 otherwise provided 3.00

32 Hunting and fishing combined licenses:

33 All persons legal residents of the state,
34 except as otherwise provided ~~5.00~~ 8.00

35 All persons legal residents of the state and

1 who are sixty-five years of age or older remain unchanged.
2 The bill also reduces the number of persons eligible for deer
3 hunting permits issued without fee.

4 During the past eleven years, the division has had only
5 two license increases of fifty cents each. During this same
6 period, the cost of maintaining and developing the fish and
7 game program has increased steadily to a point where the di-
8 vision is close to exceeding its income.

9 A change is provided in the issuance of free deer hunting
10 permits because of the apparent abuses. Last year the Com-
11 mission issued 21,477 free deer hunting permits. It is not
12 uncommon for several free permits to be issued to one family
13 including small children and nonhunting women, and to short-
14 term lessees. This bill limits the number of free deer hunting
15 licenses to one per farm unit.

1 Amend Senate File 478, page 3, by adding the following
2 new section after line 32:

3 Sec. 3. All hunting and fishing licenses issued in the
4 state of Iowa after January 1, 1972, shall contain on the
5 face thereof, in bold, type, the statement, 'Hunting (or
6 fishing, whichever is applicable) upon private property is
7 legal only with written permission of the owner or person
8 in control of such private property'.
