A BILL FOR

1 An Act reinstating the calendar year as the fiscal year for
2 cities and towns, counties, and other political subdivisions.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Acts of the General Assembly, 1972 Session of
2 the Sixty-fourth General Assembly, Chapter one thousand twenty
3 (1020), is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. It is the intent of the general assembly in
5 repealing this Act to repeal all proposed new provisions to
6 the Code of Iowa contained in Acts of the General Assembly,
7 1972 Session of the Sixty-fourth General Assembly, Chapter
8 one thousand twenty (1020), including amendments to existing
9 provisions of the Code of Iowa, prior to the effective date
10 such provisions will go into effect; however the legal
11 doctrine that the repeal of an amendatory act repeals the
12 original act or section shall not apply to this bill, it being
13 the intent of the general assembly that only the amendments
14 to the sections of the Code which are contained in chapter
15 one thousand twenty (1020) shall be repealed, not the Code
16 sections, and that such Code sections shall remain in force
17 as they were prior to the enactment of Acts of the General
18 Assembly, 1972 Session of the Sixty-fourth General Assembly,
19 Chapter one thousand twenty (1020), except as they may have
20 been or will be amended or repealed by other Acts of the
21 General Assembly.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill repeals Chapter 1020, Acts of the 64th General
24 Assembly, Second Session, and reinstates the calendar year
25 as the fiscal year for cities and towns, counties, and other
26 political subdivisions. A statement of legislative intent
27 is included in the bill to assure that the repeal of Chapter
28 1020 does not also repeal those sections of the Code which
29 are amended or repealed by Chapter 1020.
