A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to holiday days for state employees.
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
3 Section 1. Chapter thirty-three (33), Code 1973, is amended
4 by adding the following new section:

5 NEW SECTION. State employees shall receive as a holiday
6 the preceding Friday for all legal public holidays falling on
7 Saturday and the following Monday as a holiday for all legal
8 public holidays falling on Sunday. The executive council
9 may substitute the Friday immediately following Thanksgiving
10 Day as a holiday in lieu of the third Monday in February,
11 Washington's Birthday.

EXPLANATION

12
13 This bill provides that state employees receive as a holiday
14 the preceding Friday for all legal public holidays falling
15 on Saturday and the following Monday as a holiday for all legal
16 public holidays falling on Sunday.

17 It also provides that the Executive Council may substitute
18 the Friday after Thanksgiving Day for Washington's Birthday
19 as a holiday.

FISCAL NOTE

Prepared in regard to S.F. 252 - An Act relating to vacation days for state employees. Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Senate Rule 31.

No estimate available.

There are nine "Legal Public Holidays" as defined by Chapter 33, Code of Iowa, 1971. Five of these are set by the Code on a specific day of the week. The other four holidays are set on a specific date and the day of the week on which they fall varies from year to year.

In 1976 Christmas falls on a Saturday and Independence Day on a Sunday. This will be the first time in the next four years that a legal holiday comes on a week-end.
