A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to antique gambling devices.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

3 Section 1. Section seven hundred twenty-six point five
4 (726.5), Code 1973, is amended by striking the section and
5 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 726.5 POSSESSION OF GAMBLING DEVICE. "Gambling device"
7 means a gambling device as defined in section ninety-nine A
8 point one (99A.1) of the Code.

9 "Antique gambling device" means a gambling device which
10 is incapable of operation and is not used as a gambling
11 device, and which was manufactured at a much earlier time
12 than the present.

13 It is unlawful for a person to possess a gambling device.
14 However, this section shall not prohibit the possession of
15 an antique gambling device.

EXPLANATION

16 This bill legalizes the possession of antique gambling
17 devices. Antique gambling devices shall not be operable or
18 operated.
