## A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation from the general fund to  
2 the Iowa crime commission.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:  
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1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state to the Iowa crime commission for the biennium  
3 beginning July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975, the follow-  
4 ing amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be  
5 used in the manner designated:

11 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
12 of the Iowa crime commission are appropriated for the pur-  
13 pose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

14 Sec. 3. No funds appropriated by this Act shall be used  
15 for capital improvements.

16 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
17 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
18 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
19 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973  
20 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and  
21 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all  
22 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-  
23 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made  
24 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
25 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
26 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
27 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

28 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in con-  
29 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern  
30 for the biennium.

11 Sec. 2. The legislative council shall appoint a liaison

 31 for capital improvements.

32 Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
 33 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
 34 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
 35 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1973

36 shall, on August 31, 1974, revert to the state treasury and  
37 to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In all  
38 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-  
39 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made  
40 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered  
41 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
42 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
43 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

44 Sec. 6. When any of the laws of this state are in con-  
45 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern

The committee's recommendation is for a budget of \$789,000 for 1973-74 and \$802,100 for 1974-75. This budget includes a state appropriation of \$38,900 for 1973-74 and \$40,210 for 1974-75. The budget also includes federal aid of \$734,000 for 1973-74 and \$734,000 for 1974-75 and also balances carried forward of \$68,787 for 1973-74 and \$52,687 for 1974-75.

From this total, \$319,500 for 1973-74 and \$332,600 for 1974-75 is budgeted for salaries.

\$40,000 for 1973-74 and \$40,000 for 1974-75 is budgeted for travel.

\$29,500 for 1973-74 and \$29,500 for 1974-75 is budgeted for office supplies and expense, printing and binding, telephone and telegraph, and equipment.

Other expenses, which include Local Planning Grants are budgeted at \$100,000 for 1973-74 and \$100,000 for 1974-75.

The committee's recommendation allows for no increase in personnel.

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
