## A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the state board of regents for  
2 the planning, construction, and equipping of a meat laboratory  
3 at the Iowa state university of science and technology.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of  
2 the state three million (3,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary, to be used by the state board of regents  
4 and in the manner designated for expenses incurred in the planning,  
5 construction, and equipping of a meat laboratory at the Iowa state  
6 university of science and technology.

7 Sec. 2. Fees for architectural services shall be paid only  
8 for those services relating to the general contract for the  
9 actual construction of a building. It is the intent of this  
10 section that no fees shall be paid for architectural services  
11 relating to interior furniture, decorating, or other things  
12 not part of the building.

13 Sec. 3. The governor, the board of regents, or the state  
14 comptroller are authorized to obtain and accept federal funds  
15 available for use in carrying out the provisions of this Act.

16 Sec. 4. The board of regents may employ technical assistants  
17 in order to carry out the provisions of this Act.

18 Sec. 5. Any unobligated balance of funds as of June 30, 1978  
19 appropriated by this Act shall revert to the credit of the general  
20 fund on September 30, 1978.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill provides an appropriation of three million dollars  
23 for the planning, construction, and equipping of a meat laboratory  
24 at Iowa State University.
