A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the compensation of nonlegislative members
2 of the ethics committees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section sixty-eight B point ten (68B.10), unnum-
5 bered paragraph one (1), Code 1973, is amended to read as fol-
6 lows:

7 There shall be an ethics committee in the senate and an
8 ethics committee in the house, each to consist of seven mem-
9 bers; three members to be appointed by the majority leader
10 in each house, two members by the minority leader in each house
11 and two individuals who shall not be employees of the gen-
12 eral assembly by the chief justice of the Iowa supreme court.

13 The two individuals appointed by the chief justice of the
14 supreme court shall receive a per diem of forty dollars and
15 travel expenses at the same rate as paid members of interim
16 committees for attending meetings of the ethics committee.
17 Members of the general assembly shall receive a per diem of
18 forty dollars and travel expenses at the same rate as paid
19 members of interim committees for attending meetings held
20 when the general assembly is not in session. The per diem and
21 expenses shall be paid from funds appropriated by section
22 two point twelve (2.12) of the Code.

EXPLANATION

24 This bill allows the citizen members of the Ethics Committees
25 to receive \$40 per diem for attendance at meetings.
