### A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the appointment of a clerk for the civil  
2 service commission.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-five point four  
5 (365.4), unnumbered paragraph one (1), Code 1973, is amended  
6 to read as follows:

7 The chairman of the commission for each biennial period  
8 shall be the member whose term first expires. ~~In cities having~~  
9 ~~a population of more than seventy-five thousand the commission~~  
10 ~~shall appoint an employee in the city clerk's office who is~~  
11 ~~employed under the provisions of this chapter to be clerk of~~  
12 ~~the commission and his duties as such clerk shall have~~  
13 ~~precedence over any additional duties of his regular employ-~~  
14 ~~ment. In all other cities the city clerk shall be clerk of the~~  
15 ~~commission.~~ In all cities covered under this chapter the  
16 commission shall appoint an employee of the city to be clerk  
17 of the commission. In cities with directors of personnel,  
18 that person may serve as clerk.

#### EXPLANATION

19  
20 This bill provides that the commission shall appoint a city  
21 employee to be the clerk of the commission. This bill also  
22 provides a city director of personnel may be appointed as clerk  
23 of the commission.
