## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the admissibility of evidence in a trial  
2 for rape, sodomy, and incest.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Chapter seven hundred eighty-two (782), Code  
5 1973, is amended by adding the following new section:

6 NEW SECTION. INADMISSIBILITY OF EVIDENCE IN TRIALS FOR  
7 RAPE, SODOMY, AND INCEST. Evidence of the complaining wit-  
8 nesses past sexual conduct or sexual reputation shall not  
9 be admissible in a trial for rape, sodomy, or incest.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill provides that evidence of a complaining witnesses  
12 past sexual conduct is inadmissible in a trial for rape,  
13 sodomy, or incest.
