1 Section 1. Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly,
2 1973 Session, chapter one hundred three (103), section one
3 (1), unnumbered paragraph two (2), is amended to read as
4 follows:

23 Sec. 2. There is appropriated to the department of soil
24 conservation from the general fund of the state for the
25 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and ending June 30, 1975
26 the sum of fifteen thousand (15,000) dollars, or so much
27 thereof as is necessary, for employment of an engineer-
28 technician to aid in the development of conservancy district
29 plans and programs.

30 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
31 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
32 tion in The Lyon County Reporter, a newspaper published in
33 Rock Rapids, Iowa, and in the LeMars Daily Sentinel, a news-
34 paper published in LeMars, Iowa.
