A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to providing resident senior citizens fish-
2 ing and hunting licenses at no charge.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1), Code
5 1973, as amended by Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly,
6 1973 Session, chapter one hundred twenty-two (122), section
7 sixteen (16), chapter one hundred fifty-five (155), section
8 two (2), and chapter one hundred fifty-seven (157), section
9 six (6), is amended as follows:

10 1. Lines fourteen (14), fifteen (15), and sixteen (16)
11 are amended to read as follows:

12 All persons legal residents of the state and sixty-five
13 years of age or older, except as otherwise provided ~~---3-00~~,
14 may fish in this state without obtaining a license.

15 2. Lines thirty-one (31), thirty-two (32), and thirty-
16 three (33) are amended to read as follows:

17 All persons legal residents of the state, and sixty-five
18 years of age or older, except as otherwise provided ~~---3-00~~,
19 may hunt in this state without obtaining a license.

20 3. By striking lines thirty-seven (37), thirty-eight
21 (38), and thirty-nine (39).

EXPLANATION

22
23 This bill provides that legal residents of this state who
24 are sixty-five years of age or more may fish and hunt without
25 obtaining a license.
