1 Section 1. Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973
2 Session, chapter sixty-nine (69), section one (1), subsection
3 eight (8), is amended to read as follows:

10 Sec. 2. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the
11 increased appropriation made by this Act is to be used to defray
12 the additional examination expense incurred by the board of
13 physical therapy examiners as a result of the unusually large
14 number of applicants taking the physical therapy examination
15 in the year 1974.

16 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
17 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication
18 in the Hampton Times, a newspaper published in Hampton, Iowa,
19 and in the Waterloo Daily Courier, a newspaper published in
20 Waterloo, Iowa.
