A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation for the purpose of improving
2 liquor warehousing operations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of
2 the state to the Iowa beer and liquor control department for
3 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and ending June 30,
4 1975, the sum of thirty thousand (30,000) dollars, or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used to procure the
6 services of a consultant skilled in warehouse management to
7 make recommendations for improvement of the warehouse opera-
8 tions at Camp Dodge, Iowa. Recommendations shall also be made
9 on the need for additional space and the relative merits of
10 locating that space at the central location at Camp Dodge or
11 in constructing or leasing warehouse facilities in other
12 large population centers of the state.

13 Sec. 2. Funds which are not expended for the purposes
14 specified in section one (1) of this Act may be used to carry
15 out the recommendations of the consultant within the limits
16 of such funds.

1 Amend Senate File 1402 as follows:
 2 By striking everything after the enacting clause and
 3 inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 4 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general
 5 fund of the state to the Iowa beer and liquor control
 6 department the sum of one million five hundred thousand
 7 (1,500,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be
 8 necessary, to be used for expansion and development of
 9 the warehouse facilities at Camp Dodge, Iowa. The
 10 development of the warehouse facilities shall include
 11 the installation of an automated conveyor system.
 12 Sec. 2. The Iowa beer and liquor control department
 13 shall determine the feasibility of establishing and
 14 locating warehouses in other large population centers
 15 of the state and make a report regarding such feasi-
 16 bility to the committees on appropriation of the general
 17 assembly meeting in the year 1975.
 18 Sec. 3. Unencumbered funds appropriated by this
 19 Act remaining on June 30, 1976 shall revert to the
 20 general fund on August 31, 1976.

1 Amend the Committee on Appropriations amendment
 2 H-3074 to Senate File 1402 as follows:
 3 1. By striking lines 8 through 11 and inserting
 4 in lieu thereof the following: "necessary, to be
 5 used for the planning and construction of a liquor
 6 warehouse to be located in the vicinity of Cedar
 7 Rapids, Iowa, and for the installation of an auto-
 8 mated conveyor system to be located in the warehouse
 9 facilities at Camp Dodge, Iowa.
 10 For the Iowa beer and liquor control department
 11 for the planning and construction of a liquor ware-
 12 house in accordance with the plans developed under
 13 the provisions of this Act.....\$1,000,000.
 14 For the Iowa beer and liquor control department
 15 for the installation of the automated conveyor
 16 system as provided in the provisions of this
 17 Act.....\$500,00
 18 Sec. 2. Plans for the construction of the liquor
 19 warehouse shall provide for a minimum of eighty
 20 thousand square feet of usable space.
 21 Sec. 3. The director of the Iowa beer and liquor
 22 control department shall make periodic reports to the
 23 legislative council regarding the development of plans
 24 for the construction of the liquor warehouse. The
 25 actual construction of the warehouse shall commence as
 26 soon as possible after approval of the plans by the
 27 legislative council.
 28 Sec. 4. The Iowa beer and liquor control depart-
 29 ment shall make a report with respect to the progress
 30 of the liquor warehouse to the Committees on
 31 Appropriations of the general assembly meeting in
 32 the year 1975.
 33 Sec. 5. By renumbering the sections to conform
 34 with this amendment."

HOUSE AMENDMENT TO SENATE FILE 1402

1 Amend Senate File 1402 as follows:

2 By striking everything after the enacting clause and
3 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
5 of the state to the Iowa beer and liquor control department
6 the sum of one million five hundred thousand (1,500,000)
7 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
8 for expansion and development of the warehouse facilities
9 at Camp Dodge, Iowa. The development of the warehouse
10 facilities shall include the installation of an automated
11 conveyor system.

12 Sec. 2. The Iowa beer and liquor control department shall
13 determine the feasibility of establishing and locating ware-
14 houses in other large population centers of the state and
15 make a report regarding such feasibility to the committees
16 on appropriation of the general assembly meeting in the year
17 1975.

18 Sec. 3. Unencumbered funds appropriated by this Act
19 remaining on June 30, 1976 shall revert to the general
20 fund on August 31, 1976.
