A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the Iowa state fair board and convention.
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section eight point thirty-six (8.36), Code
2 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 8.36 FISCAL YEAR. The fiscal year of the government shall
4 commence on the first day of July and end on the thirtieth
5 day of June. This fiscal year shall be used for purposes
6 of making appropriations and of financial reporting and shall
7 be uniformly adopted by all departments and establishments
8 of the government. However, the fiscal year of the Iowa state
9 fair board shall commence on the first day of January and
10 end on the thirty-first day of December.

11 Sec. 2. Section one hundred seventy-three point two
12 (173.2), unnumbered paragraph one (1), Code 1975, is amended
13 to read as follows:

14 A convention shall be held at the capitol or at any other
15 place within the state, on the ~~second-Wednesday~~ third Tuesday
16 of ~~December~~ January of each year, to elect members of the
17 state fair board. The convention shall be composed of:

18 Sec. 3. Section one hundred seventy-three point four
19 (173.4), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

20 173.4 VOTING POWER. On all questions arising for
21 determination by the convention, each member present shall
22 be entitled to but one vote, and no proxies shall be recognized
23 by the convention. However, a member who is also a board
24 director at large or a board congressional director shall
25 not be entitled to vote for a successor to each of the three
26 directors at large or a successor to each congressional
27 director on the board.

28 EXPLANATION

29 This bill allows the state fair convention to meet anywhere
30 within the state and changes the convention date to the third
31 Tuesday in January. It also changes the state fair board's
32 fiscal year to end on the thirty-first day of December. It
33 further prohibits certain state fair board members from voting
34 for their successors at the convention.
